



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND OUTREACH POLICY

Objectives

- Develop and provide new opportunities for the wider community to participate in Cumann Pheadair Naofa.
- Support individuals in Warrenpoint to become more involved through provision of resources, fostering partnerships between individuals and community.
- Assist in the development of a strong and resilient community to improve the sense of connectedness and social well being of all.
- Adhere to the National GAA Code of Behaviour (underage), which can be downloaded from the Club website and the Club Child Safeguarding Statement.

Underpinning Principles

- Inclusiveness – enabling people to participate meaningfully in community-led programmes and at a level with which they are comfortable.
- Collaboration – establish and develop partnerships that aim to achieve positive outcomes for the community in finding solutions to issues which are important to them. This may include developing networks with other groups and individuals, encouraging different communities to work with CPN, and building relationships with those who are different from us.
- Capacity building – support and strengthen the individuals and community to identify needs and develop and implement solutions locally. This may involve awareness raising, education and mentoring.
- Equity – ensuring that the people involved have equal access to opportunities which are presented.
